

Top Energy Saving tips at home



You can make a difference to the electricity shortage in our country by changing the way we use energy everyday.

Geysers - It guzzles up to 39% of your monthly energy usage. Switch it off to reduce system energy demand. Don't forget to insulate the geyser and water pipes and turn your geyser temperature down to 60°C.

Shower - It uses less water than bathing and using less hot water means less work for your geyser. Use an energy and water saving showerhead since it used less water and energy.

Lighting - Replace all incandescent bulbs with energy saving Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFL's). Install Occupancy Sensors in your house, when the room is unoccupied the lights will switch off automatically.

Standby Electricity - Don't leave your TV, DVD player etc on standby mode, they use up to 80% of their operating power. Rather switch them off at the main power source and don't forget to unplug your cellular phone charger after your phone has been charged or it will continue to draw power.

Refrigeration - Close your fridge door quickly so it doesn't use extra power to get back to its optimal cooling level.
